1. Information on the process of the Technical Dialogue

Background

- Preparations for the first global stocktake (GST1) during 2021, as mandated in 19/CMA.1
- GST1 officially started at COP26 with information collection and preparation (ICP) component

GST Input phase

- SB Chairs issued a call for inputs (Parties, UN and NPS)
 - Submissions were made via UNFCCC submission portal
 - Initial version of GST information portal published (<https://unfccc.int/topics/global-stocktake/information-portal>)
- Note that, per 19/CMA.1 (para 19-25), synthesis reports and inputs for TD1 (June 2022) should have been submitted three months in advance (end of February 2022)
 - They can be updated based on new and emerging information for future TD meetings, if needed
 - Synthesis reports – under guidance of CFs; and being prepared by constituted bodies / forum / other institutional arrangements
- Webinars to clarify methodologies and assumptions used for synthesis reports before TD1



Approach to the Technical Dialogue meetings

- Technical Dialogue (TD) will address all elements of para 6(b) at each session (June 2022, Nov 2022, June 2023)
- CFs will provide an information note prior to each TD meeting and a summary report after each TD meeting.
